Dear Mr. White:

We received your April 7, 2015 letter and enclosures from a citizens group alleging that Mayor Pamela O'Connor repeatedly violated a city ordinance. As we understand it, the ordinance generally prohibits a public official from accepting campaign funds from entities that received a public benefit as a result of the official's vote.

You included a letter from the District Attorney's Office declining to take up the complaint, although your office perceived a conflict of interest in the City Attorney investigating and possibly prosecuting a member of the City Council. We recognize the potential for conflict if the City Attorney herself, who serves at the Council's pleasure, personally handles the matter. We concur with the District Attorney's Office, though, that the assignment of a deputy city attorney who is properly insulated from the rest of your office and the City Council should obviate any conflict concerns.

Thank you for bringing the matter to our attention.
